Youth Ministry Update

On a cold and windy fall night (October 31st – Halloween) 28 adults and 8 youth, ranging in age from 5-6 months to early 80's, gathered together for St. Peter's annual Trunk or Treat outreach ministry festivities.

With 14 vehicles and one fire truck assembled on the church parking lot at 5:30 pm thereabouts, we waited in anticipation to greet our guests with Christian hospitality, smiles, pleasant conversation, along with warm food (hot dogs), warm drinks (hot chocolate), cold drinks and plenty of apples (2 bushels), candy, and treats in abundance.

Around 5:40 pm the parade of children, youth, teenagers, young adults, parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, friends all began to create an awesome group of folks we greeted till near 8:00 pm.

One of our volunteers had 500 gift bags. A consultation with her at 7:40 pm gave us a count of 435 children coming through. And then more came as if a bus dropped them off in front of the church. The number climbed to at least 475! We estimated that adult family members was well over 300+ more.

We were <u>tired</u>, but <u>overjoyed</u>, <u>sleepy</u> but full of <u>excitement</u> to talk about our experience, <u>cold</u> but <u>surely</u> <u>warmed in our hearts</u> to mingle with everyone, absolutely believing that we were in a 'holy place' in the Presence of our Lord Jesus, feeling the fellowship and love of God's people with our neighbors and our community in which we all dwell.
